3. Read **Genesis 2:7-24** as a group. What stands out to you in these verses? What questions do you have? What do you think it means for "two to be united into one"?
4. Pastor Jim said, "Most of us keep some kind of score in our marriage." Do you ever find yourself keeping score in your relationships (marriage and others)? Do you usually give others a generous score or a low score? How does this impact the relationship?
5. What is one step you could take to be more like Jesus in your relationship with your spouse? Read Philippians 2:3-7 for a reminder of Jesus' attitude. Ask the group to pray for your humility and unselfishness.
