2. Discuss the idea that “marriage is a covenant, not a contract.” What is the difference between a covenant and a contract? How could embracing this principle impact a marriage?
3. Read Ephesians 5:21-33 as a group. What stands out to you in these verses? What questions do you have? Look closely at v. 33. Why do you think Paul exhorts husbands to “love” and wives to “respect”? What can we learn from this?
4. Look over the list of Emotional Needs. Which one stands out to you as a need that you may have. Why? Do you have an example of how that need gets met in a way that makes you feel very loved?
5. How can a husband and wife leverage their differences to decorate their marriage? How will you apply this to your marriage as you learn to love your spouse?
